Bay Leaf is native of Mediterranean and grow widely in scrub land woods in Europe and California. It widely cultivated in Europe, America and Arabian countries. It is not cultivated as a commercial crop in India.

Bay leaves are used as flavouring in soups, stews, meat, fish, sauces and in confectionaries. Both leaves and fruits possess aromatic, stimulant and narcotic properties. The essential oil from the leaves are also used as spice and food flavouring agent and has wider application in traditional medicines of different countries. The major functional properties are anti-microbial, anti-fungal, hypoglycaemic, anti-ulcerogenic etc.

Due to its various uses and benefits, bay leaf export from India has been on the rise over the last few years. Bay leaf export from India includes the export of different varieties of the product.

Odour And Flavour:

Subtle Flavour. No Mustiness Or Rancidity, Characteristic Of Celery States where the crop is grown and cultivated are Punjab ((Jalandhar, Gurdaspur and Amritsar districts), Haryana and western Uttar Pradesh (Ladhwa and Saharanpur districts) over an area of about 5000 ha.

Out of the total cultivation of Indian celery seeds, majority of its produce is exported to the **USA, followed by the Netherlands, South Africa, and Australia.**

MUSTARD SEEDS

Mustard is an annual herb that serves multiple purposes, including use as an oilseed crop, vegetable, or fodder. Among its species, three stand out for their condiment value: pale yellow or white mustard (*Brassica hirta*), brown mustard (*Brassica juncea*), and black mustard (*Brassica nigra*). The plant produces alternate, long, bristly branched leaves, which are hairy on both sides. Furthermore, its flowers are small, yellow, and feature four cruciform petals. The seeds, which measure between 1.5 and 3 millimeters, are a key component in various culinary and industrial applications.

India is the third largest producer of rapeseed-mustard after Canada, China and contributing to around 14 % of world's total production. With the production of 13.2 million tons during 2023-24, rapeseed-mustard became the first largest oilseed crop in India. In 2023, India exported \$33.6M in Mustard seeds, making it the 4th largest exporter of Mustard seeds in the world.
