ABOUT US

NCEL is a multi-state cooperative society registered under the MSCS Act, 2002. It is jointly promoted by some of the leading cooperative societies in the country, namely the Gujarat Cooperative Milk Marketing Federation (GCMMF), popularly known as AMUL; the Indian Farmers Fertiliser Cooperative Limited (IFFCO); the Krishak Bharati Cooperative Limited (KRIBHCO); and the National Agricultural Cooperative Marketing Federation of India Limited (NAFED). Additionally, the National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC), a statutory corporation under the Ministry of Cooperation, is one of its promoter members.





NCEL promotes cooperative exports through various activities, including procurement, storage, processing, marketing, branding, labeling, packaging, certification, research and development, and trading of all types of goods and services produced by cooperative societies. We also play a role in providing technical guidance, training and capacity building, developing and maintaining market intelligence systems, assisting cooperatives financially, implementing relevant government schemes, and undertaking any other activities that facilitate the increase of exports from the cooperative sector and related entities.



We are a specialized cooperative society committed to addressing export market challenges, including intense competition, monopolistic practices, unethical trade behaviors, inadequate infrastructure, and issues related to standardization.

We operate with the support of both state and central ministries through their export-related policies, schemes, and agencies, following the 'Whole of Government Approach'.
